

跳脫兒童空間固有印象,打造一座等待被填滿的藝廊, 淨白的空間與強烈的黑色框架成為畫布,提供孩子繪上自我的色彩。

給孩子們的空間是否必須滿是圓潤線條、童稚圖樣或甜美色彩?如何定義出「兒童空間」?何宗憲透過此作提出了不同的思考。位於深圳大型購物中心內,基地為三層的獨棟建築,提供3至12歲孩童課外培養美感、提升創作力的藝術訓練,課程安排多元,包含靜態的繪畫、手作,或動態如戲劇表演、烹飪等,業主強調不同於一般興趣導向的才藝班,而是更加專注培養孩子在藝術方面的可能性,因此定位為藝術學院。回應品牌的教育理念,何宗憲大膽提出大量留白的空間,如同一面畫板,令孩子們盡情揮灑創意與個性,設計簡潔線條,跳脫固有想像。期待透過創作、想像的過程引起孩童興趣,而非單一裝置、遊具等玩樂,何宗憲表示,現代孩童在學校、家中皆充斥著甜美或浮誇的風格,彷彿孩子們無法理解純粹之美,他比喻:「吃多了甜食總是會膩,有一種淡淡的口味反而能產生好的反應。」以此說服業主與老師,空間提供多元可能性,搭配教育內容,提供孩子不一樣的環境。

多元教育空間

空間淨白,光影便成為最好的畫筆,處處利用大面落地窗引入日光,空間動線更依據採光面規劃,打開頂層天窗及室外平台作為餐廳與烹飪教室;挑高的2樓安排正式劇場,鄰近採光面則為開放式表演空間;基地1樓與地下層設置多處錯層平台,1樓臨窗處安排靜態的「繪本平台」,地下層則設置多種不同機能教室。1樓的繪本平台強調「分享」,除了共同閱讀繪本,亦提供家長、學童與教師互動,也是表演、活動的聚集之處,連接通往各個區域。設計自繪本出發,希望孩子不僅閱讀故事,更身處於故事之中,將錯層空間結合經典童話「三隻小豬」,房屋造型的平台搭配材質變化仿擬故事中的茅草屋、木屋與磚屋,並增加爬網、滑梯等設施,提供孩童活動場域。此外,亦打造多個抬高的盒狀空間,作為孩子成長階段需要卻往往缺乏的半私人領域,那裡會是他們的小天地,與朋友們談天遊戲,盡情探索空間的各種可能性。

另個重點即是 2 樓的表演空間,中央保留作為正式劇場使用,中軸對稱的氣派布局, 搭配燈具勾勒出的線條,提煉自傳統劇院造型,使用的燈光、音響設備皆為專業等級。



臨窗採光面則安排開放式表演平台,並運用大量玻璃磚維持光線通透感,其中一道牆體藉由材質的接合做出類似砌牆至一半、未完成之感,使教學跳脫封閉的教室空間,打造完整的表演區域。由於戲劇表演常有場景布置的需求,設計上亦盡量留白,維持開放乾淨的空間。其餘教室則集中於地下層,設計靈感來自藝術家們布滿顏料、畫架的工作室,期待孩童沉浸於同樣創作氛圍中,因此有些教室便以儲藏概念形成空間,將框架融入設計,提供老師放置材料、工具,使創作的過程自然地填滿了空白的教室。此外,教室內亦規劃小型獨立空間,提供坐不住的孩子能離開硬性座位探索靈感,或者將裁縫教室的尺規鑲嵌於地面,創造多元化的教學模式。

給孩子的畫廊

何宗憲觀察兒童在成長階段常模仿大人行為,設計刻意塑造出正式如藝廊一般的氛圍,令孩子藉由環境體驗真實的藝術環境。空間調性簡潔乾淨,材質的變化與光影便成為主角,以材料提升兒童的敏銳度與想像力,加上盒狀的空間與線條,凝聚出純粹的力量。淨白主色調跳脫固有「兒童空間」的框架,使老師與孩子的存在成為空間中最顯眼的色彩,何宗憲強調,此處的白不意味著「乾淨」,而是「等待填滿」的期待。除了主體的白以外,更以工整、乾淨的黑色垂直線條強調空間俐落感,刻意放大尺度,加深線條比例與幾何概念,框出的盒狀空間則吸引孩子前往探索。在細處如洗手間或討論教室等,使用弧形燈光與線條緩和空間,減少空間的剛硬強烈感。

儘管大人們總擔心空間太過成熟,但孩子們都能 夠接受並喜愛,更加投入課程、創作中,證明設計 能夠跨越年齡與美感。何宗憲也認為,設計師應隨 著時代前進,勇於嘗試挑戰框架,引起業主反思固 有觀念。採訪」林慧慈



What is a perfect space for kids? There are many common cartoon images of the perfect embellishments for kids' spaces, but Joey Ho doubted them. Located inside a mall in Shenzhen, MEIYI Royal Kindergarten Education Center offers children aged from 3 to 12 the opportunity to cultivate their aesthetic sensibility through multiple courses including hand-working, painting, theatrical practice, and cooking. This is not a typical day camp but rather a institute for future artists. In response to the program, Joey proposed a very bold design; he kept the space clean and most of the walls plain white to induce children to paint on them. Joey believes the best education for art training is not the typical courses but rather to encourage kids to try and see space as the incubator to nurture their minds through the dare to challenge and try.

Multiple purpose space

The building of this Institute is full of natural light through both large windows and a skylight. The cooking space and dining lounge can directly access an outdoor balcony, and a double height theater faces a big window that joins both indoor and outdoor spaces. The level 1 floor and basement is linked by multiple level stages which can be used for sitting and reading books or as a place for conversion amongst students, teachers and parents. The basement houses several classrooms. Picture books inspired Joey's design. The reading stages appear as three houses apparently derived from the Three Little Pigs, and a climbing web, slides and other venturing elements are integrated into the design. Below the stages, there are several boxes for kids to hide within.






The second floor is a theatrical space. The central zone is a formal theater, equipped with professional lighting and audio systems. The space offers a flexible stage and an empty backstage for any necessary expansion or additions to meet the furnishing demands for various performances. All classrooms are grouped in the basement and the design concept is inspired by a painter's studio where easels, paint tables, and pigment tubes are the elements of the space. Inside the classroom are small pocket zones for kids to stay doing nothing or playing with rulers and other drawing instruments in the space.


Children's gallery


Joey has a theory that kids' mimic adults' behaviors that shape their perception and guides their views of interacting with the world so the space in this Institute represents a miniature world where art gallery, public zone are small representations of the real world. White color is used



extensively like an art gallery and the "colorless" space is not empty but waiting to be filled by kids' handiwork and creations. There are several dark color framed elements that increase the spatial rhythm and provide visual orientation. Lighting design enhances the ambience that is intimate and friendly.

Joey's design at first was challenged by parents who believed the space was not "cute" enough, but true observation reveals the kids' overwhelming acceptance.
